On Monday Penrith & District Farmers' Mart LLP held their Annual January Bonanza Show and Sale of 623 Store Cattle, kindly sponsored by PFK Rural & I'Anson Quality Feeds. Bonanza by name, Bonanza by nature. An outstanding run of cattle with a sale oozing with quality throughout. Huge credit to the vendors. Bullocks sell to average £2135; heifers average £2071.

Topping today's sale at a blistering £3220 came for todays Champion a British Blue Bullock at 20 months old from Mr B Duffton, Bogie Street purchased, by Mr D Barker. The top price Heifer came from the Strong Family at Hewer Hill for a beautiful Black Limousin Heifer with White socks and belly purchased by Messrs Cowan, The Ash to make into a cow. This homes run of Black heifers mostly found there way back to be potential suckler cows, 12 of them heifers sold to average £2,718.

Some great runs of cattle throughout the sale Messrs Strong, Well House set the trade a light with his run of 8 strong stores selling to average £2656.25. Messrs D W & T A Bell, High Dyke sold another run of 6 to average £2539. Messrs R G Todd & Son, Crosby Hall sold 4 Native bred Bullocks to average out at £2503 topping this homes run was an Aberdeen Angus Bullock at 28mths old achieving £3000 respectively.

Once again, the Wales Family, Thackwood brought forward there thumping run of 25 strong stores to £2715 for Charolais bullocks and the run averaging out at £2473.80. A great offering of younger stores were also on offer. Elliott Bros, Harbour Flat sold 8 at 14 months old to average £2348.75.

Dairy bred cattle continue the flying trade here in Penrith. Messrs H W & J Birkbeck, Castle Hill travelled up from Kirkby Stephen with some great Black & White bullocks selling to £2165 and £2065.

We would again like to thank both vendors & purchasers for coming to Penrith and making the sale a great success.
