Suffolk lambs soared to £140 for a pen of 9 from Mr G Ostle, Welpo Bridge Farm. Mule lambs caught the trade again here in Penrith with JH Little, Bank End Mill selling a pen of 26 at £136. A wholesale average of £108 was achieved and more are needed to fulfil demand here in Penrith.
