- The FABBBL status of all cattle will be displayed at time of sale.
- All cattle over 42 days of age from TB testing parishes 1 must be pre-movement tested and a copy of the vet's certificate presented with the passports, the TB status will be displayed at time of sale.
- Customers and vendors are reminded to observe and obey DEFRA regulations in place in the mart, see notices.
- All passports must be correct and must accompany cattle to the mart.
- All cattle must have two Ministry approval tags before being presented at the mart and these must match the relevant passports.
- Any cattle with only one tag or incorrect passports will be sent home.
- Please note the public are requested to dip their feet when leaving the livestock areas.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

The chains on the loading dock gates must be used at all times. This is especially important when unloading and loading cattle at which time the gates should be firmly secured to the trailer or lorry. Vendors are to be held responsible if cattle escape due to negligence.

Children below the age of 16 are forbidden from entering the cattle penning area or ring, other than at the sole risk of the accompanying adult.
