Peter travels throughout Northern England and Southern Scotland,
keeping the UK's sheep free of scab and other ecto-parasites



Peter tells us, 'dipping is the only way to ensure complete and targeted control of scabs, lice, ticks, keds & blowfly in one treatment.

However, many farmers aren't registered to dip, which is where I come in. As a licensed dipper I travel to farms around the country, dipping sheep with **Gold Fleece OP dip**.

Dipping gives immediate scab & ecto-parasite control and dipping for scab helps to prevent the over-use of type 3 (3ML) wormers, which could lead to resistance. I use the country's number one dip, **Gold Fleece**, which has a short 49 day meat withdrawal'.
